

MORE INFO NEEDED ON ID CARDS FOR K-12 & HIGHER ED INSTITUTIONS

AR HB1770 Bill Passed by Arkansas State Legislature.

Update Must be Done Before School Year Begins.



When the Arkansas State Legislature passed Bill HB1770 into law, it set a new standard for student identification cards, and with the new school year just weeks away, many school administrators may not realize they have some serious homework to do before they go back to school.

In short, the bill, now known as ACT 1069 requires public schools grades six - 12 and all two- and four-year higher education institutions to add the following national hotline information to ID badges to enrolled students:

- Domestic Violence
- Sexual Assault
- Suicide Prevention
